## Cost

Currently, more than 100,000 men, women, and children are waiting for an organ or tissue transplant in the United State. Approximately one-third of those people receive a life saving transplant and hope for a renewed life each year. This is due to the generosity of individuals who think of others in need at a time of their own personal grief. Despite this generosity, the need continues to grow. Each day 17 people die while waiting for a transplant and a new name is added to the transplant list every 8 minutes.
